OUR WORK

The Magic Bus project started in October 2013 and is working with 500 children around Sarjapur area in Bangalore.

IMPACT

- Sensitization of around 500 children in and around Sarjapur area on importance of education, gender issues and health hygiene
- 20 youth leaders from the community would be trained and assisted to take up leadership roles in the community

DETAILS

Magic Bus enables some of the world's poorest families to move out of poverty, through the use of a mentoring model and a sport-based curriculum, it engages children and ensures that they make the right choices so that they have a constructive journey from childhood all the way through towards better and dignified livelihoods as adults.

The organization's philosophy revolves around the concept of mentoring. Young people from the communities in which they intervene, volunteer to work with Magic Bus. They are trained over an extended period of time to emerge as able Community Youth Leaders. They function then as Mentors for children in the community, with whom they conduct weekly sessions based on a well-researched, activity-based curriculum that Magic Bus has developed. As Mentors they become enablers of learning not only during sessions, but also role models for children across the community.
