

# ANANDA VIDYALAY, GURGAON



## OUR WORK

In Gurgaon, Wipro Cares works with Ananda Vidyalaya to provide underprivileged children holistic care with specific emphasis on education. The project is using the 'Right to Education' bill to mainstream meritorious children into formal channels of education.



## IMPACT

- 100 children who are denied the opportunity to education are supported
- The school emphasizes on holistic care of the children

## DETAILS

Ananda Vidyalaya, under the umbrella of Dhyani Yog Society is an educational initiative. It is dedicated to working with children, families, and their communities to reach to their full potential by tackling the causes of poverty and injustice. It serves all people, regardless of religion, race, ethnicity or gender. Currently, two educational centers are operational:

- Gurgaon Centre: S13/13 and S13/16 DLF, Phase III, Gurgaon
- Shakti Nagar centre, 39/14, Shakti Nagar, New Delhi

The Anand Vidayalya Schools work with nearly 100 children (on an average) catering to the age group 4 to 14 years under the C.B.S.E method of education from nursery to class IV. The school provides these children basic education, clothing, food and health checkups. The children learn painting, music and are also trained in basic etiquettes and hygiene. They are provided with basic stationery and a fortnightly langar is arranged for them.

The Society has been successful in getting nearly 25 of their students admitted in private CBSE affiliated schools. The focus is to get nearly 10-15 students enrolled every year in private schools so that these children get integrated into the mainstream education system. Thus, the purpose of Anand Vidyalaya is to become a bridge school and help children to join mainstream education.
