

AMALNER HEALTHCARE PROJECT



CONTEXT

Amalner Healthcare Project is one of our most recent projects; it was started in January 2012. Amalner is considered as the birth place of Wipro; currently we have a Wipro Consumer Care & Lighting Group (WCCLG) plant situated in Amalner. The five villages selected for the project lack adequate healthcare facilities. Amalner is a drought prone taluka, only 3% land is irrigated. People do not have a continuous source of livelihood, most of the people living in the area are either small farmer or labourers. The people of these villages are unaware of the various healthcare services that are available to them. The project aims at providing curative and preventive healthcare facilities along with working towards increasing the efficacy of existing healthcare infrastructure and services.

PARTNER

Adhar Bahhuudeshiya Sanstha is an NGO Working in North Maharashtra region of Maharashtra. Since 1999, ADHAR has been working on alleviating the problems faced by women and children along with livelihood generation through micro financing.

DETAILS

The primary objectives and expected outcomes of the project are:

Objectives

- To provide comprehensive primary health service, regular health camps and awareness generation on various issues of health and hygiene
- To achieve 100% early registration, pregnancy services, institutional deliveries
- Spread awareness to stop female foeticide

Expected Outcome

- Quality primary healthcare services available to the population of 5 villages
- To increase institutional delivery in the area, and ensure adequate prenatal and neonatal care
- Build the capacities of the VHSC (Village Health & Sanitation Committee) in the area
